



COVID-19 INFORMATION AND LIBRARY UPDATES

Due to current guidance from public health officials and as a precaution to help limit the spread of coronavirus and promote social distancing, the Library will be **CLOSED to the public through April 19, 2020**. We will reassess the situation at that time.

Please keep all borrowed materials until the library reopens, as the book drop will be locked. **The loan period for all borrowed items has been extended to May 1, 2020. Late fines will be waived through Friday, May 15, 2020.**
